The City of Las Vegas Solid Waste Transfer Station will soon be under construction to complete a total revamp of its facilities which will take place over a period of about four months. Improvements include the replacement and/or repairs of doors, electrical panels and lighting, fire emergency system, heating, exhaust and much more. The City, in its efforts to promote sustainable practices, will be installing a heating system that runs solely on used motor oil. In addition, with the help of the City Recycling and Keep America Beautiful Coordinators, the Transfer Station continues to collect recyclables and hopes to expand these services in the near future. The proposed renovations will also help prevent trash from escaping the collection containers, a much needed solution in our windy climate.
