SPRING FORWARD MOVE AHEAD **CITY TO MEET WITH WARD TWO RESIDENTS REGARDING CLEANUP**

LAS VEGAS, NM – Spring cleaning fever has hit the city of Las Vegas. Under the direction of Mayor Tony E. Marquez Jr. and the city council, City Manager Tim Dodge, has created a community cleanup. The cleanup is part of the administration's goal to beautify the city. Each ward will have an amnesty day at the city's solid waste transfer station. Ward Two residents will have their amnesty day at the city's Solid Waste Transfer Station is on April 18, 2009. A community wide cleanup is scheduled for May 2, 2009.

The amnesty day for ward three residents is on May 2, 2009. On May 4, 2009 the city will host a meeting for ward four residents to discuss the cleanup at the Senior Citizen's center. The amnesty day for ward four residents is on May 9, 2009. The ward one meeting will take place on Monday, May 11, 2009 and the ward one amnesty day is May 16, 2009 for ward one residents.
