## CITY MUSEUM EXTENDS HOURS

Beginning July 10, the City Museum will be open on Friday and Saturday afternoons until 6 p.m. “A lot of visitors travel during the day and arrive in town later in the afternoon. The longer hours will allow them to visit the Museum, especially if they’re leaving early the next morning,” remarked David Anderson, Museum staffer. Local visitors will benefit from the longer hours, making family visits possible after work or recreation activities.

*Scrapbooking Las Vegas*, the Museum’s newest exhibit, will be on display throughout the summer. The exhibit features images of people and places of Las Vegas’s past and includes an activity station where visitors can add their own memories. Other displays in the Museum include a dollhouse, memorabilia of Theodore Roosevelt’s Rough Riders, the interior of a typical northern New Mexico home in three time periods, and information about the Duncan Opera House.

The Museum is located at 727 Grand Avenue, between University Avenue and National Avenue. Hours are Tuesday through Thursday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Friday and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. during July and August.
