

**MONTHLY REPORT FOR  
ABE MONTOYA RECREATION CENTER  
OCTOBER 2011**

1. **LIGHTING** – Replacement of lighting throughout the recreation center is ongoing at this time. Replacement lights were installed in the pool and staff is working through facility.
2. **FILTERS** – Staff and community service people have been cleaning all vents throughout the facility. The vents in the fitness center have been cleaned and filters have been placed in a few vents to assist with better quality air.
3. **SAFETY** – Maintenance staff is meeting on a regular basis to discuss safety policy, safety tips, and weekly priorities for the rec center.
4. **ENERGY EFFICIENT FIXTURES** – Staff is currently working on replacing shower heads throughout the facility. Next they will begin replacing toilets and urinals. Through a report from Soleil West, the recreation center has been identified as an area to replace many plumbing fixtures such as shower heads, toilets, urinals and faucets to become more energy efficient.
5. **RECREATION PROGRAMS** – Through the recreation staff, new classes, leagues, special events and programs are being planned for the fall and winter:
  - a. **Learn to play Guitar** – Tuesday and Thursdays at 6:15pm; next class is December/January.
  - b. **Introductory Art Classes** – Making faces and Copy cats are first two classes offered. The Making Faces class will begin November 7<sup>th</sup> and will meet every Monday at 5:30pm. Students will learn to paint and draw faces. The Copy Cats class will begin November 12 students will copy paintings each week of famous artists. Class begins Nov. 12<sup>th</sup> and will meet every Saturday at 10am. Fee is \$40.00 for 12 hours of instruction each class with a \$10.00 lab fee for materials. Join both classes for \$65.00 and receive a savings for 24 hours of instruction.
  - c. **Racquetball league** – Begins in November. League options include singles, doubles and mixed doubles. Beginner, Intermediate and advanced divisions. \$20.00 for singles and if in singles and doubles its \$30.00 registration fee. One night a week will be designated as league night.
  - d. **Coed Volleyball league** – Begins in November. Rosters available. \$200.00 team for an 8 game schedule.
  - e. **Youth basketball league** – Taking registrations for the GIRLS league and COED k-2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Evaluations in November and games begin in December/January. Boys league registrations will begin in December and games will be January/ February.
- **Tony E. Marquez Jr. Fitness Challenge** – 165 participants in this 8 week challenge. Challenge continues until November 18, 2011. Co-sponsorship with Alta Vista Regional Hospital and Subway.
