We, the City of Las Vegas, would graciously like to thank the **City of Las Vegas Citizens** for their support in using taxpayer dollars towards re-surfacing improvements on our streets that line the beautiful Meadow City. The money spent was well worth improving the city's appearance.

The entire project cost the City approximately \$1.1 million. The City used \$500,000 from the gas tax fund which is a fund that is restricted for street improvements only. The other \$500,000 came from the general fund which was money generated from franchise fees for the maintenance of right-of-ways. In addition, COOP grants were obtained to help supplement the cost as well.

Many of the streets in Las Vegas have been restored. Some of the streets include: Union St. from Bernal St. to Sapello St., Collins Dr. from Legion Dr. to Peggy Lane, Bernal St. from New Mexico Ave. to South Pacific Ave., Chavez St. from Rincon St. to Grand Ave., Church Street to Taos St., and many more Streets are in constant need of repair.
